History: Through the Ages (Stone Age, Iron Age and Bronze Age)

Art: Contrast and Complement (Watercolours), Prehistoric Pots (Clay)

RE: Trees as symbols

Health & Wellbeing: Being in my world.

French: I am learning French and Animals

Computing: Networks and the Internet
