What is the portal?

The Parent Information Portal is a brand new platform designed to give you digital access to manage your appointments with your Health Visitor, School Nurse or Family Nurse, if you receive your care from Southern Health NHS Foundation Trust (SHFT).

What can I do on the portal?



View and manage your appointments with Health Visitors, School Nurses and Family Nurses



View your child's vaccination history



Search a wide range of resources about children's health

National Childhood Measurement Programme. Receive results of your child's height and weight measurements (Year R and Year 6).



The Ages and Stages questionnaire will be available for you to complete electronically before your child's development assessment appointment.

HOW TO SIGN UP: A STEP BY STEP GUIDE

You will need to provide verification of your own and your child's details to SHFT. This will generate an email to be sent to you inviting you to register on the portal.
